## Kenneally to make 'Kenneally History' compulsory

Federal election candidate Mathew Kenneally announced today that, if elected, he will force states to teach a new subject known as "Kenneally History", at all year levels K through 12. The new curriculum will draw from more than 7000 milestones in Mathew Kenneally's personal history, from the first arrival of his ancestors to this wide brown and completely uninhabited land, to what Mat himself had for breakfast last Tuesday. "Sustain, in case you were wondering" said a deadly serious Kenneally at this morning's press call.

"History is being taught without any sense of structured narrative and replaced by a fragmented stew of themes and issues. Not enough pivotal facts and dates are being taught.
